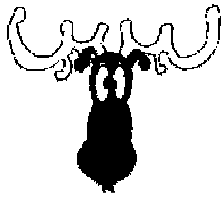
PRIZES NEEDED

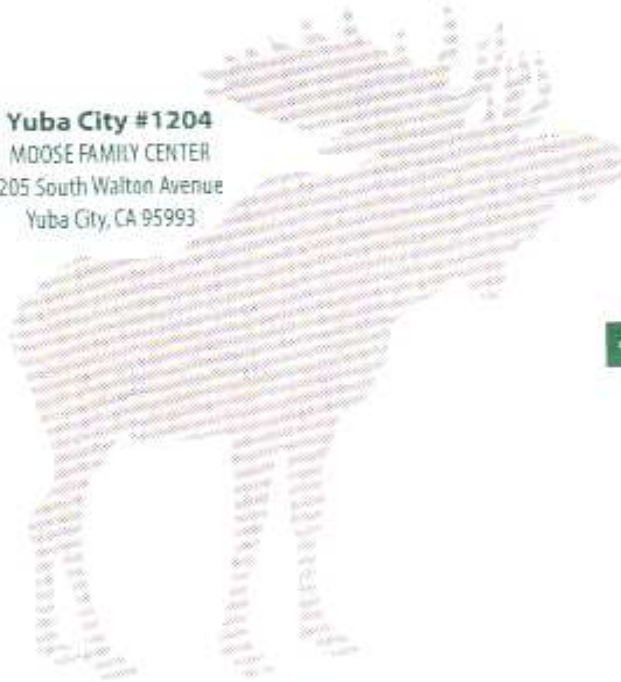
