women of the Moose put on one of the best Luau's we've had. I will not attempt to thank them individually since I will probably overlook someone but thanks to all for your hard work.

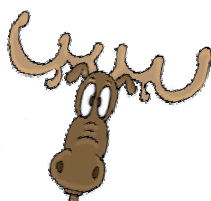
We are still trying to decide what to do with the floors. If you know someone who wants to give us a bid please have them turn it into the office.

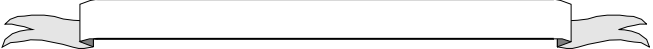

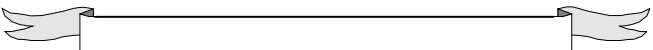
THE MOOSE CALL

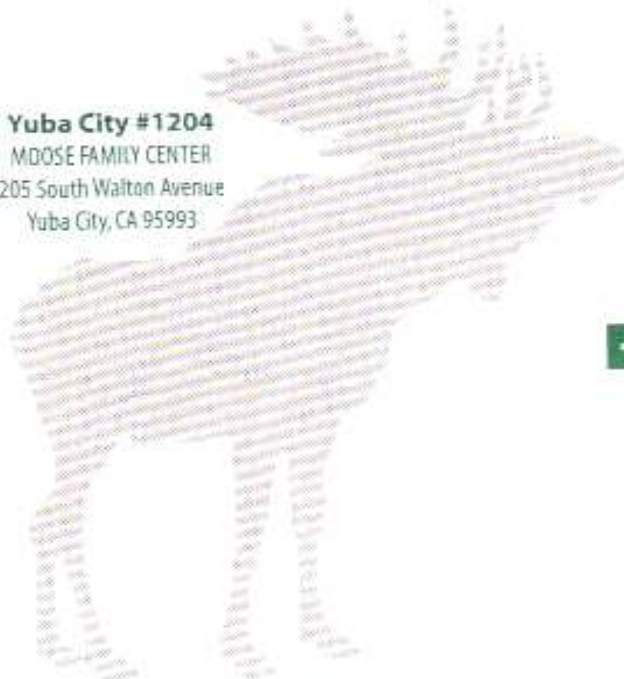
